Academic Counselling

Academic counselling is an integral part at DDE and the counsellor acts as a link between the distance learners and the institution. The counselling sessions help in developing a conducive environment blended with academic and non-academic components to ensure complete learning for the distance learners through active participation and engagement. The sessions are planned in multiple ways to make them effective. This increases the level of learning of the required skills and plays a pivot role in resolving academic ailments of the learners. Academic counselling motivates the learners and contributes to achieving the learning objectives.

The various formats of the session include:

- Physical interaction: These sessions are conducted through classroom mode where learners interact with the counsellors and clarify their doubts. The University has adopted the blended mode for interaction with students as it enables better reach and access for interaction among students. The recordings of the sessions are uploaded on to the LMS portal for students to facilitate asynchronous learning engagement. The average views for each of the programs are well above 2,00,000 views. Each course will have an average of 5000 to 8000 views during the year.
- **Doubt Clarification:** The doubt clarification sessions are scheduled in blended mode to facilitate participation of students either physical or virtual. However, some of the students do send their doubts through email which are duly addressed by the counsellors through email or during doubt clearing sessions held.
- Guidance and Counselling: Guidance to students takes many forms at CDOE. The guidance sessions include, academic guidance relating to specific course or choice of course elective, project and internship guidance, career counselling and professional counselling. The students tend to use multiple channels to reach out to the faculty to seek such guidance and counselling. The university organises special sessions for academic guidance for projects, internships, and special sessions on career prospects through experts etc. catering to the students' diverse guidance requirements. The students also have the option of emailing to the university or use the chat facility to seek guidance. Students also walk in to the CDOE campus to interact with faculty and subject experts seeking guidance

from them. Special session is organised on the weekends where experts are also invited to share their knowledge and other days to facilitate students to acquire competencies which help the learners in their career and academic progression.

• **Discussion Forum:** Discussion forums can be initiated by the student or the faculty. The discussion forum feature enables students or faculty to initiate a point of discussion which them can be replied by the faculty or other students of the batch. Discussion forum which is available online for both learners and counsellors gives the opportunity to share their views and knowledge on the subjects, facilitating better sharing of knowledge and creative thinking and acting as an extended classroom.

Value Addition

Keeping in mind the diversity in learner profile and access to contemporary practices and knowledge, the university organises special sessions, guest lectures, webinars, quiz, activities, etc. thereby encouraging students to participate in such sessions that bring cross functional knowledge to the table of the students. The University attempts to conduct one session every week on domain specific areas as well as contemporary issues of relevance and importance to the student. These sessions are conducted to enhance the skills and employability quotient of the learners by equipping them to correlate theoretical knowledge with the real-life scenario. They also help in infusing confidence amongst learners and develop confidence in them to complete their course without any hurdles.

During the last year, the University has responded through specific emails:

- Assignments: <u>assignments.cde@jainuniversity.ac.in</u> for queries relating to doubts and submissions to be made for formative assessments through submission of assignments.

Personal Contact Programs conducted:

• The University has conducted over 526 personal contact sessions covering the eight programs being offered by the ODL division of CDOE.

Student Support

In DDE, several modes are available to attend, interact and place feasible solutions on learners' queries. The important modes used in practice in the academic year 2020-21 are:

- *Call center*: A call center has been set up to manage and resolve student's queries. Students may call on Helpline number: 080-47096207
- App based support: An Android based app LearninGo is provided to all the students.
- *E-mail support*: There are 4 dedicated emails for ODL Student Support, Query segregation.

- *Web-conferencing*: Interactive workshops are managed in UMS for all the students. Practical, Project Orientation etc. are done through Interactive Sessions.
- *IMS Tickets Incident Management System*: Students are provided with the IMS Ticketing option to 'Raise a Ticket' on their studies and get their query resolved with turnaround time of 72 Hours. If there is any escalation, it is informed to the student along with an indicative timeline for resolving the query.
