- Application form duly filled in all respects.
- Registered Affidavit in case of name change/DOB change.
- Caste certificate for MBA/MCA/MSC if their percentage in degree is below 50% and above 45% - ONLY APPLICABLE FOR SC/ST STUDENTS.
- ABC ID is mandatory.
